LASQUETI INTERNET ACCESS SOCIETY A non-profit society in the Province of British Columbia

CONSTITUTION

- I. NAME: The name of the Society shall be "Lasqueti Internet Access Society."
- II. PURPOSE: The purpose of the Society is to develop and promote the shared use of computers and other digital communications technologies by the residents of Lasqueti Island for personal and economic development purposes and to promote the educational uses of these technologies.
- III. LOCATION: The operations of the Society are to be chiefly carried out in the community of Lasqueti Island, British Columbia, and surrounding areas.
- IV. STRUCTURE: The Society shall be directed and supervised by an elected Board of Directors to consist of five or more directors who shall also act as the officers of the Society for a term of one year. The Board of Directors will be elected at each annual general meeting of the Society. Membership in the Society shall be open to anyone living on Lasqueti Island.
- V. NON-PROFIT NATURE: The operations of the Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other accretions to the Society shall be used solely for promoting its purpose.
- VI. DISSOLUTION: Prior to dissolution or winding up of the Society, any assets shall be assigned and turned over to the Lasqueti Community Association, a recognized charitable organization in the province of British Columbia.
- VII. UNALTERABLE CLAUSES: Clauses IV, V and VI above are unalterable in accordance with Section 17 of the Societies Act.
